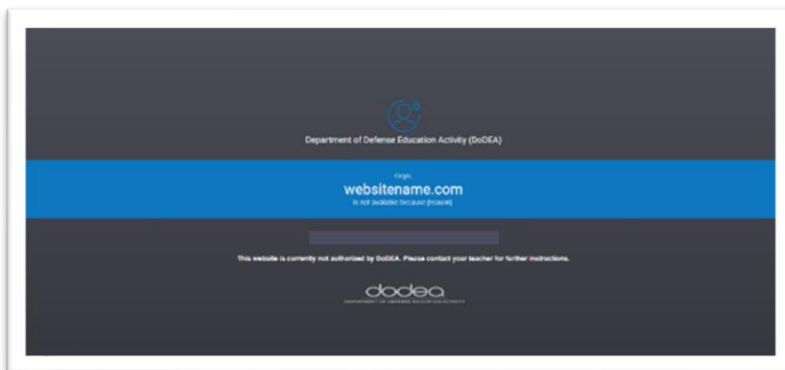




Dear DoDEA Family,

With technology-based assignments and online research continuing to expand as part of the curriculum, it's important to protect student devices everywhere. DoDEA will begin using Lightspeed Filter on DoDEA Chromebooks to help ensure a safe online experience whether students use the device at school or elsewhere.

Every effort is being made to avoid interruptions of valid curriculum access. However, if content that is needed for school research or an assignment is blocked, the student should notify the classroom teacher who can work with the school's technology staff to resolve the issue.



The blocked page will identify the URL of the blocked content as well as the category that has been assigned to the content in brackets []. This information is important to share with the teacher. The student may write down the information or provide a screenshot of the page if possible. If a student attempts to access a blocked site 10 times in 60 seconds, the account will be locked for five minutes.
